# Two sides.atn - User manual

### General purpose

This action is meant to improve an image that roughly consists of rather dark and rather light areas, and not much in-between. The action simply lightens darks and darkens lights, to bring them closer together and provide a more natural look. The Picture Postcard Workflow (PPW) suggests a procedure called "False Profile" which I find somewhat cumbersome. The "Two sides" action is a simpler way that nevertheless gives equivalent results.

#### Layer structure

The action creates a group "Bring two halves together" consisting of two layers. From bottom to top these are:

- Lighten dark areas a curves layer that lighens considerably; the mask targets dark image areas
- Darken light areas a curves layer that darkens considerably; the mask targets light image areas

## Compatibility

The action runs in all (not too old) versions of Photoshop.

### <u>Limitations</u>, <u>drawbacks</u> and <u>pitfalls</u>

- The action discards any active selection.
- The action is supposed to run in RGB. In LAB, the action runs without error but has no effect. In CMYK, it runs and works okay but gives a slightly darker result than in RGB because of the presence of the Black channel.

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
